"If you're going to be drinking this weekend, make sure organizing a sober ride home is in your game plan. Taking a few minutes to arrange for a way home before you night begins can prevent a tragedy on the road."

- Make sure you have food and non-alcoholic/low alcoholic beverages available.
- Serve drinks yourself, rather than have guests serve themselves, so you can monitor how much your guests have been drinking.
- Don't serve alcohol to anyone who is intoxicated.
- Know how your guests are getting home and who is driving. Use #TAXI or have the number of cab companies available. Be prepared to have intoxicated guests spend the night.
- Stop serving alcohol long before you expect the party to break up.
- Keep track of your own alcohol consumption. The more you drink, the more difficult it will be for you to anticipate problems, supervise the event and intervene to avoid potential problems.
